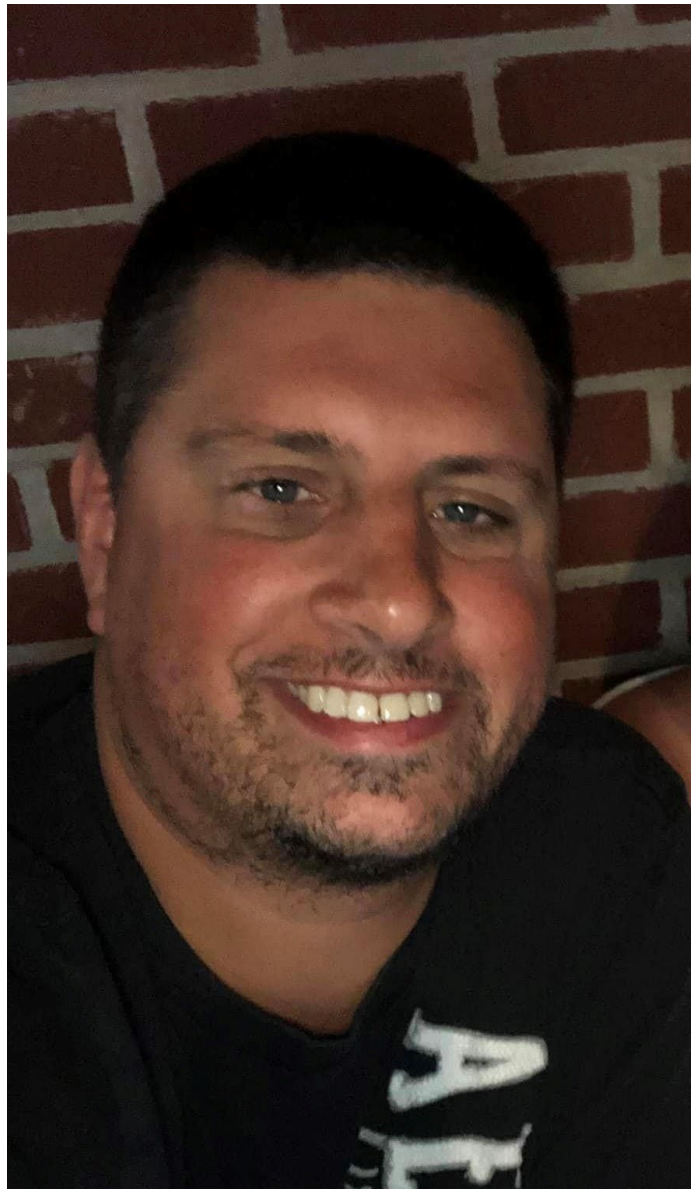

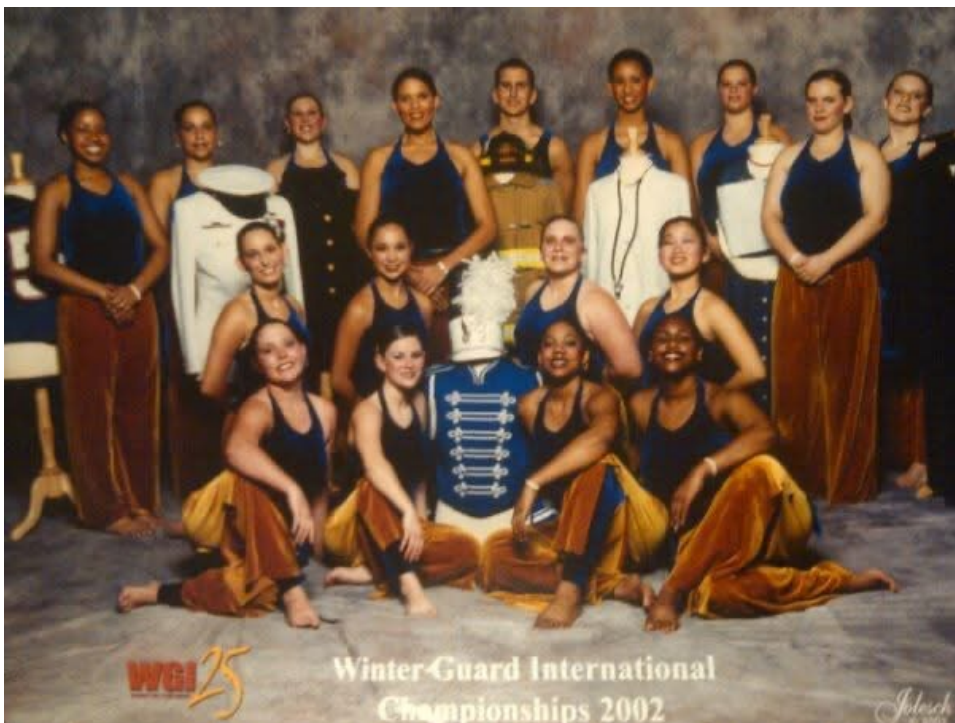
The guard attended the South Regional in Pensacola placing 2nd with 83.70
